5 **Background**

6 House Bill (HB) 1755, 88th Texas Legislature, Regular Session (2023), directs TWC to establish  
7 and administer the Lone Star Workforce of the Future Fund program. Additionally, statute  
8 required TWC to establish an Advisory Board consisting of education and workforce  
9 stakeholders to assist the commission in administering the program. The Advisory Board met on  
10 March 6, 2024, to discuss and recommend program parameters that could then be presented to  
11 the Commission for final approval.

13 **Issue**

14 The Lone Star Workforce of the Future Fund was allocated \$2.5 million for fiscal year 2024.  
15 Statute requires the Commission to adopt a list of high-demand occupations in high-growth  
16 career fields. Entities that receive funding under this chapter must facilitate the successful  
17 transition of at least 50 percent of training program participants from low wage work or  
18 unemployment to a full-time, high-demand, and high-growth occupation offering a self-sufficient  
19 wage. The Advisory Board made the following recommendations for FY 2024.

- 20 • Advisory Board recommends the approval of a statewide high growth, high-demand  
21 occupation list consisting of 266 occupations.
- 22 • Advisory Board recommends the approval of a maximum award amount per grantee per  
23 funding cycle of \$250,000, with an unlimited number of applications per grantee per  
24 funding cycle so long as the total amount funded does not exceed \$250,000.
- 25 • Advisory Board recommends the approval of a target cost per program participant of  
26 \$7,500.  
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28 **Decision Point**

29 Staff seeks the approval of program parameters as recommended by the Lone Star Workforce of  
30 the Future Fund Advisory Board.
