


Extended Unemployment Benefits in Texas

If you are eligible for a benefit extension after you exhaust your unemployment benefits, TWC will mail you a letter about the additional benefits you may receive, so make sure TWC has your current address.



Regardless of any balance in your Emergency Unemployment Compensation claim, you only have until December 28, 2013 to receive payment of those funds.

* On March 1, 2013, mandatory federal spending cuts (known as "sequestration") went into effect. These spending cuts reduce both your weekly benefit and the total amount of EUC you may receive. From benefit week ending April 6, 2013, through September 28, 2013, payments were reduced by 10.7%. From benefit week ending October 5, 2013, through December 28, 2013, payments are reduced by 7.2%. EUC recipients will receive a letter explaining the reduction.

Note: Beginning January 6, 2013, TWC was not eligible to pay EUC Tier 3. If you qualified for Tier 3 by January 5, 2013, you may continue to receive the balance remaining on your EUC claim. In addition, TWC was not eligible to pay EUC Tier 3 from July 8, 2012, through October 6, 2012.
