

## TEXAS WORKFORCE COMMISSION MEETING

The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) will attend a regional meeting on May 15, 2018 at:

TWC invites the public to attend a public meeting to provide feedback on several workforce solutions programs. TWC is soliciting feedback on the required two-year plan modification of the Program Years 2016–2019 Combined State Plan for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). The WIOA plan covers all core programs, including adult, dislocated worker, and youth, Wagner-Peyser Employment Service, Adult Education and Literacy, and Vocational Rehabilitation, as well as two partner programs: the Senior Community Service Employment Program and Wagner-Peyser Agricultural Outreach.

In addition, TWC is seeking input on the Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) Plan for Program Years 2019-2021. The CCDF Plan includes sections on consumer education, providing stable financial assistance to families, ensuring equal access, health and safety standards, and continuous quality improvement among others. This plan is the first since states fully implemented the changes mandated by the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 2014. Both plans are required to be submitted to their respective federal agencies no later than June 30, 2018.

TWC is also soliciting feedback on vocational rehabilitation (VR) services. Specifically, TWC is seeking input from customers, stakeholders, community partners and providers on a service design for non-residential brain injury services that will engage customers with brain injuries when they are best able to actively pursue and achieve a successful employment outcome; innovative strategies to assist VR customers with neurodevelopmental disorders to obtain and retain competitive integrated employment; opportunities to improve employment outcomes for all VR customers; and innovative strategies to deliver effective pre-employment transition services to students with disabilities.
