LANDLORD: “Congratulations! You are the newest member of our apartment complex and residential community. Here are just a few simple rules, no animals, parking is first-come-first serve, no other individuals allowed to stay with you, and under no circumstances do we grant special requests or accommodations. These are our rules and everyone must abide by them.”

RESIDENT: “But I told you, because of my disability I have to have an entry ramp...”

LANDLORD: “...Nope...”

RESIDENT: “...I need a parking space close to my unit...”

LANDLORD: “...Not a chance...”

RESIDENT: “...I have to have a support animal...”

LANDLORD: “...Forget it...”

RESIDENT: “...And, I have to have a home health aide...”

LANDLORD: “...Impossible.”
