How do employers participate?

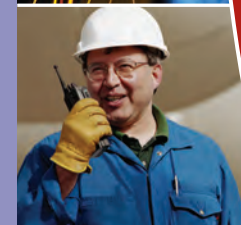

Incentives for employing out-of-work Texans

Employers have a great opportunity to help put Texas Back to Work

Texas Back to Work promotes increased productivity and business growth, while defraying the costs associated with increasing your workforce. By hiring from this highly qualified pool of workers, who have lost their jobs through no fault of their own, you have the ability to select pre-screened qualified individuals, hiring prospective employees at your discretion, saving labor costs, and training employees to meet your individual business needs.

Employers may receive a wage subsidy

Participating employers may receive up to \$2,000 in wage subsidies for each Texan hired that was receiving unemployment insurance benefits.

Additionally, new employees hired under this program may qualify for a Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC). To determine if new employees qualify employers for WOTC, contact the Texas Workforce Commission WOTC unit at 1-800-695-6879.
