

June 2015 Seasonally Adjusted Labor Market Data

- June marked the third straight month of job growth as Texas added 16,700 nonagricultural jobs. Over the year, Texas has seen an increase of 269,900 positions.
- The state has added jobs in 56 of the last 57 months, including 53,600 positions in the first half of 2015.
- The state's unemployment rate fell to 4.2 percent in June, down from 4.3 percent in May.
- June job gains were led by the Education and Health Services industry which added 10,100 positions.
- Employers in Professional and Business Services expanded payrolls for the third straight month with the addition 8,300 jobs.
