The Skills for Transition Program (STP) is a new initiative designed to work with military service members who are preparing to separate from service within 180 days, or who have been discharged within 180 days and will remain in Texas.

Receive up to \$2,000 toward training courses!

The goal of Operation Welcome Home is to provide a clear pathway for military service members as you transition to civilian employment in Texas. The Skills for Transition Program offers training in high demand occupations identified by the Texas Workforce Solutions Local Workforce Development Boards.

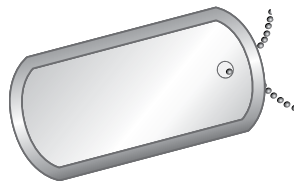

Up to \$2,000 per participant for training

Transitioning service members may be eligible for up to \$2,000 per participant for training in occupations listed on the Workforce Solutions Borderplex High-Demand Target Occupation List. Funds may be used toward courses as well as to pay for certification exams, as industry recognized credentials are preferred. The program is designed for military

service members preparing to separate from service within 180 days, plan to remain in Texas, and are verified to receive discharge with anything but dishonorable discharge. WSB will coordinate this effort in partnership with Ft. Bliss officials. There is no cost to the service member or the military.
